Neurofeedback uses a feedback electroencephalogram (EEG) to show the trainee current electrical patterns in his or her cortex Clinical training with feedback EEG then enables the individual to modify those patterns, normalizing or optimizing brain activity Neurofeedback practice is growing rapidly, with the widest
