Human evolutionary psychology and animal behaviour

There are various labels for such work, including evolutionary psychology, human behavioural ecology and human sociobiology Collectively, we call these areas 'human evolutionary psychology' (HEP) because their shared objective is an evolutionary understanding of human information processing and decision making
